This £9million scheme close to the Tower of London, is the first British development for Wombat’s, the Austrian hostel provider already established in Vienna, Berlin, Munich and Budapest. The project combines a 1950s-brick building with a 19th century Grade II-listed building which was formerly used a seaman’s mission and a homeless shelter.

Putney & Wood won the contract to design, supply and install new Moleanos limestone on the Dock Street facade. The smart design and use of stone cladding elevates the streetscape, and while it is a relatively small project for the company, our attention to detail was as meticulous as on any of our multi-million pound contracts. This is exemplified with the award from the Stone Federation in recognition of the outstanding workmanship.
